Living It Out: ***(What action step is God guiding your heart to take?)***

Take time to consider all your Heavenly Father has created so that you can give thanks and praise to Him for His work.

Seeing It Happen: ***(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)***

Have faith that your Heavenly Father made the universe as a gift to enjoy and give thanks to Him for His creation.

Get Ready To Share: ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group what from nature you are thankful that your Heavenly Father created.
