My son has already taken care of that for you on the cross. He has already secured your forgiveness and cleansing.** I know, I am so thankful. **How thankful?** **Are you willing to take steps to turn away from sin when it attempts to entice you again?** Yes, I am. **Do you have something specific in mind?** Yes, I do.

You have asked for a clean heart and a pure mind, haven't you? Yes, I have. **How do you think that will happen?** I don't know. **That seems obvious to me. Do you realize that every day you are presented with a choice of what you will feed your heart and mind?** How is that? **Everything you hear or see enters your heart and mind. Confess your sins to God. Receive forgiveness through Christ. Allow God to transform your heart and mind by His word.

Seeing It Happen:

(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)

Have faith that your sins are forgiven and that God is creating a pure heart in you.

Get Ready To Share:

(What can you share with others from your heart?)

Share with another person or your small group how God has been creating a pure heart and mind in you.
