Clay

If I am reluctant or unwilling to allow you to mold and shape me then your work will be hindered. **Yes, it will.**

Why is important for you to know that you are the work of my hands? I need to know and remember and expect that you will continually be molding and shaping my life according to your design. Your work will never stop. You will use your word to shape me. You will use circumstances to mold me. You will use other people to mold and shape me. You will use the ministry that you have called me to do for you to mold and shape me. You will use my participation in the body of Christ to mold and shape me. You will use all of life to mold and shape me into the person you want me to become. **Yes, I will.** I will not always understand how you are molding and shaping my life. **No, you will not.** I need to know and remember that I am a work in your hands. I need to have faith in you. I need to trust you. I need to be patient and let your work continue. **Yes, you do. Will you?** Yes Lord, I will.
