God's word was like a sword fighting against the devil and all his evil. **Yes, you are right. You will do well if you let the word of God fight in you, with you and for you.**

I have even more to say. **I'm still listening.** You have set before me an example. You have shown me how important it is for me to know the word of God. **Yes, I have.** God's word will strengthen me against every temptation. God's word will make me able to stand against every evil. **Yes, it will.** A challenge is before me. Questions are being asked of me. Will I make God's word my food? Will I feast on the word of God? Will I meditate on God's word day and night? Will I let God's word dwell in me richly? You are asking me these questions. **Yes, I am.** Lord, I will do what you have done. I will follow your example. I will hide God's word in my heart and mind so that I can live the life you have called me to live. **That will be very good.**
