If you want to bear fruit for my kingdom and reap a rich and bountiful harvest you must not give up. You must not grow weary. You must not faint. You must not quit.** I understand.

Let's talk about this a little more. I'm listening. **You will never have enough of your own strength to go and do all that I ask of you. If you rely on your own strength you will grow weary, you will become faint and you will want to give up and quit. Remember, that I said that my hand would be on you. I said that I would use you.** I remember. **You must rely on me for all the strength you will need to go and do all that I ask of you. I will work in you and through you. You will go and do what you could have never do without my help.** So, there are really two, "ifs" to receiving all these promises from you? I will bear fruit for your kingdom and reap a rich harvest for you "if" I rely on you and "if" I don't give up. Is that right? **Yes, that's right. Will you rely on me? Will you never give up? Will you keep on serving me?** Yes Lord, I will.

Get Ready To Share:

(What can you share with others from your heart?)

Share with another person or your small group how you are not growing weary of continuing to serve the Lord.
