Your Example

It was your joy to lay your life down as a sacrifice for the sins of the world. You broke down the wall that divided me from you. You forgave all my sins. You cleansed all my unrighteousness. You made my slate clean. You gave me a second chance. You gave me a fresh start. You became my Savior and Lord. You loved me when I was unlovable. **Yes, I did.**

What will you do? I will do whatever you ask of me. I will go wherever you guide me. I will do all the good that you give me to do for others. I will pour myself out in your service. I will live my life with and for you. It will be my joy to serve you. It is my hope to bear a rich harvest for you. I want to bear fruit for your kingdom and bring glory to your name. That is my dream. That is my desire. That is my prayer. **That is very good. That is what I will do in and through you.**

Have faith that you will reap a rich harvest for God's kingdom as you continually do good things for others.

Get Ready To Share: ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group how you are making every effort to do good things for others.
