Stand Firm

Stay right there, stand firm where you are right now. Where am I right now? **You have been set free. You are living in the freedom that I have secured for you. You have a hold of me. Yes, I have a firm hold on you. I am your Savior and Lord. I am your God and Father. You are my child. You are under my protection. You can walk freely to where I lead you. You have the power to do what I ask of you. So, I will say it again, “Stand firm, in the freedom that I have secured for you”.**

How can I stand firm in the freedom that you have secured for me? How can I make sure that I will not let myself be burdened again by a yoke of slavery? **You will not go where you should not go. You will not do what you should not do.** How will this be sure and true? **You will draw near to me as I draw near to you. You will submit yourself to me, resist the devil and all his evil. Then he will flee from you. Don't think that you can resist the devil and all his evil with your own will and strength. If you try, you will surely fail. It is in your drawing near to me and submitting yourself to me that you will continue in the freedom and victory that I have secured for you.**

What has happened to you as you have continued to draw near to me? As I have continued to draw near to you, my love for you has grown stronger every day. Every day it is the desire of my heart to live my life with and for you. I hunger for you. I thirst for you. I want to know you. I want to know your will. I want to walk in your ways. In every way, I want to do what is pleasing to you, not because I should or must, but because I love you with all my heart and mind and soul and strength. **What has happened to your desire for sin as you have continued to draw near to me?** Sin has lost its attraction. Sin has lost its appeal. I would much rather walk through life with you than live in sin. **That is very good. Keep on drawing near to me and you will never again submit yourself to a yoke of slavery to sin.**

Lord, I know you have set me free. You have made it so I can walk in your freedom. No longer will I live as a slave in bondage to sin. I will never allow myself to be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. I will live with you, in the fullness of life, you have given to me. Amen

Christ has set us free to live a free life. So take your stand! Never again let anyone put a harness of slavery on you.

MSG Galatians 5:1

Freedom *Made Us Free*

IN [this] freedom Christ has made us free [and completely liberated us]; stand fast then, and do not be hampered *and* held ensnared *and* submit again to a yoke of slavery [which you have once put off].

AMP Galatians 5:1

Freedom *Made Us Free*

So Christ has made us free. Now make sure that you stay free, and don't get all tied up again in the chains of slavery to Jewish laws and ceremonies.

NLT Galatians 5:1

Freedom *Set Us Free*

It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

NASB Galatians 5:1

Freedom *Made Us Free*

We have freedom now, because Christ made us free. So stand strong. Do not change and go back into the slavery of the law.

How has your new life in Christ made you dead to sin that at one time ruled over your life?

Living It Out: ***(What action step is God guiding your heart to take?)***

Stand firm against sin and darkness in the world by drawing near to God and resisting the devil and all his evil?

Seeing It Happen: ***(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)***

Have faith that Jesus Christ has set you free so that you can live and walk in His freedom.

Get Ready To Share: ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group how Jesus Christ has set you free to live in His freedom.
