You turned my life around. You helped me to draw near to you as you drew near to me. You forgave my sin. You cleansed me of all my unrighteousness. How are you making the Lord known to others that need Him as their Savior and Lord?

What are you most thankful to the Lord for what He has done or is doing for you?

How are you proclaiming the name of the Lord and offering yourself in worship to Him?

Living It Out:

(What action step is God guiding your heart to take?)

Let your life be an example of thankfulness to the Lord for who He is and what He has done.

Seeing It Happen:

(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)

Have faith that the Lord is worthy of all your thanks, praise and worship for who He is and for what He has done.

Get Ready To Share:

(What can you share with others from your heart?)

Share with another person or your small group how you are proclaiming the name of the Lord to those who need Him.
