## **Wait**

It is not better than being in your presence. Pick a spot anywhere in the universe. I would rather be in your presence. Pick something else to do. I would rather meet with you. Pick something else to hear. I would rather hear from you. Your words refresh me. Your words revive me. I am given encouragement and hope and strength as I meet with you. I am given guidance and direction as I hear from you. **That is very good.**

I have this hunger and thirst within me that only you can satisfy. I could have everything the world has to offer and yet I would hunger for more than it could possibly provide. You fill me up. You feed my hunger. You satisfy my thirst. I will seek you with all my heart and mind and soul and strength. There is something I know for certain. **What's that?** I will find you. I will find you right here, right now, in the morning as I meet with you. **Why are you so certain?** Your word is sure. Your word is trustworthy. I can hold on to the promises of your word. **What promises?** You have said that I will find you when I seek you with all my heart. You have said that you will draw near to me as I draw near to you. I am seeking you. I am drawing near to you. Here I am, right here, right now. I know that you are here to help me. I know that you are here to feed and sustain and strengthen me. I know that you are here to guard and guide me. I know that you are here to give me hope and encouragement as I love you with all my heart and soul and strength. You are all I need. You are all I want. I am yours. You are my God and Father. **Yes, I am. I am here with you. In me, you will have all you need. Yes, you will find me when you seek me with all your heart. Yes, I will draw near to you as you draw near to me. Yes, I will meet with you in the morning. Wait for me.** Yes Lord, I will. **That will be very good.**

The Lord is good to those who wait hopefully and expectantly for Him, to those who seek Him [inquire of and for Him and require Him by right of necessity and on the authority of God's word]. It is good that one should hope in and wait quietly for the salvation (the safety and ease) of the Lord.

**Seeing It Happen:** ***(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)***

Have faith that the Lord will show you new things about Himself as you meet with Him.

**Get Ready To Share:** ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group when you wait for and seek the Lord in your life.

**Close With Prayer:**
