I want others to receive what I have received from you. **Will you keep on telling others all that I have done for you?** Yes Lord, I will. **That will be very good.**

Make sure to give thanks and praise to the Lord by telling others all that He has done for you.

Seeing It Happen: ***(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)***

Have faith that the Lord will not reject your prayers or withhold His love from you.

Get Ready To Share: ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group how the Lord has heard and answered your prayers.
