Give Thanks

You healed my bruised and battered and broken life. You restored me into a relationship with you. You adopted me into your family. You have made me to be your own child. You have set me apart to love, follow and serve you. You are molding and shaping my life. You are giving me new thoughts to think, words to speak and deeds to do. Day by day you are making me to be more like you. One day I will come to live forever in heaven with you. **Yes, you will.** That's a lot to be thankful for. **Yes, it is.**

But, you want to make some changes? You want to live your life differently? Yes, I do. I want to acknowledge you every day in every way. I want to stop to consider all the good things you have done, are doing and will do in my life. I don't want to live an ungrateful, unthankful and thoughtless life. I don't want to miss an opportunity to give thanks and praise to you. **That will be very good.**

I have heard you say that you want your life to be filled with joy. That's true. **You said that as one of my followers there should be more joy coming out of your life. You stated that others ought to see joy overflowing your life and be drawn to me. Did I hear you correctly?** Yes, you did. **I agree with you. I want to see joy overflowing your life. Why is not more joy overflowing your life? What will cause you to live a more joyful life?** I see where this is headed. **That's good.** As I stop to give you thanks and praise for your goodness, My life will begin to overflow with joy. **That's right. One more thing.** What's that? **You are forgiven.** Thank you, Lord.

Heavenly Father, thank you for your goodness to me. You have done, are doing and will continue to do good things for me, of that I have no doubt. I am grateful. I am thankful. I will give you all my thanks and praise for the good things you have done for me. Amen

Miracles *Came Back To Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!"*

One of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back to Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!" He fell to the ground at Jesus' feet, thanking him for what he had done. This man was a Samaritan.

NLT Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Returned, And With A Loud Voice Glorified God.*

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

NKJV Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Turned Back, Praising God*

Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan.

NRSV Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Turned Around And Came Back, Glorifying God*

One of them, when he realized that he was healed, turned around and came back, shouting his gratitude, glorifying God. He kneeled at Jesus' feet, so grateful. He couldn't thank him enough—and he was a Samaritan.

MSG Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Turned Back, Recognizing And Thanking And Praising God*

Then one of them, upon seeing that he was cured, turned back, recognizing and thanking and praising God with a loud voice; And he fell prostrate at Jesus' feet, thanking Him [over and over]. And he was a Samaritan.

AMP Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Thanking Him*

One of them came back to Jesus, shouting, "Glory to God, I'm healed!" He fell flat on the ground in front of Jesus, face downward in the dust, thanking him for what he had done. This man was a despised Samaritan.

TLB Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Turned Back, Glorifying God*

Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan.

NASB Luke 17:15-16

Miracles *Went Back To Jesus, Praising God*

When one of them saw that he was healed, he went back to Jesus, praising God in a loud voice. Then he bowed down at Jesus' feet and thanked him. (And this man was a Samaritan.)
