You have given me your courage and strength. You have made me bold and steady. You have given me all I have needed to accomplish your plans and fulfill your purposes. It is only because I have relied on you that I have been able to bear fruit for your kingdom and bring glory to your name. Only in my weakness have I come to know that your power was resting on me. **That's is very good.**

So, I give you thanks and praise for not making me strong. Thank you for causing me to come to rely on you. Thank you for working in and through my life. Thank you that I can live and walk in an intimate relationship with you. Seeing It Happen: *(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)*

Have faith that the Lord will work in and through your weaknesses.

Get Ready To Share: *(What can you share with others from your heart?)*

Share with another person or your small group how the Lord has worked in and through your weakness.
