None of these desires could have originated in me. **That's true. These desires did not originate in you.** That gives me great confidence. **Why is that?** I know that you are both a giver and granter of desires. I know that I can confidently ask you to grant a desire that you have clearly placed in my heart. **Yes, you can.** So, I will receive what I want by asking for it from you. I will seek you with all my heart and mind and soul and strength. I will keep on asking you to set me on fire for you. I will keep on asking you to make me burn white hot for you. I will keep on asking you to help me to faithfully go where you guide me to boldly do what you ask of me. Then I will shine brightly like a star in the universe for you. Then I will bear fruit for your kingdom and bring glory to your name. **Yes, you will.**

Share with another person or your small group how the Lord speaking to you has ignited your desire to serve Him.
