## **Last Resort?**

I have learned one thing. **What's that?** I have learned that apart from you I can accomplish nothing of true and lasting and eternal value. I don't want to live a life apart from you. I don't my life to be an accumulation of check marks off of an insignificant to do list. **What do you want?** I want to live in an intimate relationship with you. I want to hear your voice. I want to live in an ongoing prayer dialogue with you. I want to talk with you about anything and everything. I want you to teach me how to pray. I want you to give me prayers to pray. I want to be able to pray prayers that you will hear and answer. **Those are all very good desires.** I'm sure that these desires come from you. **Yes, they do.**

**What must you do if you want to live a life of prayer? What must you do if you want me to teach you to pray? What must you do if you want to be able to pray prayers that I will hear and answer?** I must meet with you in prayer. I must set aside a time and a place when and where I can begin to develop a daily pattern of meeting with you in prayer. I must enter your prayer classroom. **Will you do that? Will you ask, will you seek, will you knock in prayer?** Yes Lord, I will. **That will be very good.**

*Lord, I will not remain silent. I will not "go it alone". I will rely on you. I will make my needs known to you. I will be persistent, and passionate in the prayers I pray. I will ask. I will seek. I will knock. I will wait patiently for you to hear and answer my prayers. Amen*
