That is not the life that I am calling you to live.** Yes, I know. So, it will be very easy to determine if I am really listening to you. My old human and earthly and natural life looks nothing like the life you are calling me to live. **No, it does not.** You are calling to live a godly, spiritual and supernatural life that will stand out as a bold and bright witness for you in the world. You want me to love my enemies. You want me to do good to those who hate me. You want me to bless those who curse me. You want me to pray for those mistreat me. You want me to treat others just how I would like to be treated. **Yes, I do.** I am excited about living this kind of life. I will happily listen to you. I will joyfully follow your example. **Why is that? What is the cause of your excitement, happiness and joy?** I know that you will help me to live this kind of life. You will make me able to live like you lived. You will cause me to be a bold and bright witness for you in the world. **Yes, I will.** Nothing is better than that. **Listen to me and follow my example.** Yes Lord, I will. **That is very good.**

Give away to everyone who begs of you [who is in want of necessities], and of him who takes away from you your goods, do not demand or require them back again. And as you would like and desire that men would do to you, do exactly so to them.
