Give thanks and praise to the Lord for His being your rock and refuge, shield and strength and deliverer.

Seeing It Happen: ***(What are you trusting God for in your heart?)***

Have faith that you can rely on the Lord to be your rock and refuge, shield and strength and deliverer?

Get Ready To Share: ***(What can you share with others from your heart?)***

Share with another person or your small group how thankful you are for the Lord delivering out of troubles in life.
