## **Your Example**

You didn't want to have your own way. You did what your Heavenly Father required of you. **What was that? What will be required of you?** I will be required to walk in humility. Walking in humility is the only way that I can live a life that is pleasing to God. Walking in humility is the only way that I can live the life I am being called to live. Walking in humility is the example you have set before me. **That's true.**

**What else will be required of you? What other examples have I set before you?** I will be required to act justly. **What does that mean?** I'm not positive. I know that I won't be able to walk indifferently past injustice in the world around me anymore. **No, you won't.** I'm sure that you will want me to keep my eyes and ears open to you. You will show me how to act justly in the world around me. **Yes, I will.**

**What else will be required of you? What is another example that I have set before you?** You have loved me. You have loved me when I was unlovable. You have not given me what I deserve. You have given me what I did not deserve. Instead of judgement you gave me mercy. Instead of condemnation you gave me forgiveness and salvation. **Yes, I did. Will you love others as I have loved you? Will you extend to others the same mercy that I have shown to you?** Yes Lord, I will. **That will be very good.**

*Lord, thank you for showing me what is good. I want to follow your example. I want to live the kind of life that you lived. I will do what you require of me. I will act justly. I will love mercy. I will walk humbly with you in all that I think, say and do as I follow you. Amen*
